1. Proposed Opening of the Permanent Rulemaking Process to Consider Amendments to Commission's Permanent Rules

The Commission will consider opening the Permanent Rulemaking process for amendments to the Commission's Permanent Rules. If proposed Permanent Rules are adopted and submitted for legislative review on or before April 1, 2018, the Legislature will have until the end of the 2018 legislative session to approve or disapprove the rules.

Possible Action:

Possible action may include, but is not limited to: taking no action; approving the beginning of the permanent rulemaking process as proposed, or as modified at the meeting, by publication in *The Oklahoma Register* and scheduling of a public hearing; not approving the opening of the rulemaking process; or continuing the matter.

2. <u>Proposed Opening of the Form Adoption, Revision and Repealer Process to Consider New Forms, Form Revisions and Form Repealers to the Current Workers' Compensation Commission forms</u>

Title 85A O.S. § 22 provides before the adoption, amendment or modification of any form, the Commission shall give thirty (30) days' notice of its intended action and provide an opportunity for public comment, following the rulemaking process. The Commission will consider opening the form adoption, revision and repealer process to provide for necessary modifications to forms and potentially adopting new forms to provide for processes not currently addressed by the existing forms.

Possible Action:

Possible action may include, but is not limited to: taking no action; approving the beginning of the form adoption, revision and repealer process to adopt new forms, amend the Commission's forms or repeal forms; or continuing the matter.
