1. Discussion and Public Comment on Proposed Amended Medical Fee Schedule

Title 85A O.S. § 50(H)(1) states the Commission shall conduct a review of the Fee Schedule every two (2) years. The Commission contracted with an external consultant to develop a report on the current Fee Schedule and to provide data to help the Commission develop a proposed amended Fee Schedule. The Commission provided a thirty-day comment period

from January 28, 2020, to February 27, 2020. The Commission solicited comments from the public, to be provided via email to <u>feeschedule@wcc.ok.gov</u>.

The Commission will discuss the report and the draft proposed Fee Schedule and will hear public comments. Representatives of the consultant, FAIR Health, may be recognized to share additional information, including methodology, data points, or trends, with the Commission and speakers, as needed.
