## 2020 ANNUAL REPORT OF THE PHYSICIAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON WORKERS' COMPENSATION

### I. INTRODUCTION

The Physician Advisory Committee on Workers' Compensation, created by 85A O.S. § 17 serves as an advisory body to the Oklahoma Workers' Compensation Commission. This report identifies the progress and activities of the Council during calendar year 2020.

Membership of the Council in 2020 included: William R. Gillock, M.D., Chairman; Robert L. Remondino, M.D., Vice Chair; David Garrett, D.P.M.; James Rhodes, D.C.; C.B. Pettigrew, D.O.; LeRoy Young, D.O.; Jeff Duncan, D.O.; Gabriel Pittman, D.O. A current membership list, including medical specialty and appointing authority, is included in the appendices to this report. Staff support for the committee is provided by the Oklahoma Workers' Compensation Commission as provided in 85A O.S. § 17.

#### II. STATUTORY DUTIES

- The statutory duties of the Physician Advisory Committee are set forth in 85A O.S. § 17(B), a copy of which is included in the Appendix. These duties include to:Assist and advise the Workers' Compensation Commission regarding utilization review as it relates to the medical practice and treatment of work-related injuries. Such utilization review shall include a review of reasonable and necessary medical treatment; abusive practices; needless treatments, testing, or procedures; or a pattern of billing in excess of or in violation of the Schedule of Medical Fees. The Physician Advisory Committee shall review and make findings and recommendations to the Commission with respect to charges of inappropriate or unnecessary treatment or procedures, abusive practices, or excessive billing disclosed through utilization review;
- Assist the Commission in reviewing medical practices of health care providers, including
  evaluations of permanent disability provided by health care providers. The Committee
  shall review and make findings and recommendations to the Commission with respect to
  charges of abusive practices by health care providers providing medical services or
  evaluations of permanent partial disability through the workers' compensation system;
- After public hearing, review and make recommendations for acceptable deviations from the American Medical Association's "Guides to the Evaluation of Permanent Impairment";
- After public hearing, adopt Physician Advisory Committee Guidelines (PACG) and protocols for only medical treatment not addressed by the latest edition of the Official Disability Guidelines;

- After public hearing, adopt Physician Advisory Committee Guidelines for the prescription and dispensing of any controlled substance included in Schedule II of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act if not addressed by the current edition of the Official Disability Guidelines;
- Review utilization on cases or of providers when requested by any employer, injured employee or insurer. The Committee may issue a public or private censure to any provider for utilization which is excessive or inadequate, or recommend the Commission order treatment within the treatment guidelines;
- Provide general recommendations to the Commission on the issues of injury causation and apportionment;
- Conduct educational seminars for the Commission, employers, employees, and other interested parties;
- Assist the Commission in accessing medical information from scientific literature; and
- Report its progress annually to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

#### **III. 2020 ACTIVITIES**

During 2020, the Physician Advisory Committee discussed deviation from the AMA guides, Sixth Edition's shoulder impairment ratings, Senate Bill 1418, the 2020 Medical Fee Schedule, chronic pain management, and Drugs of Abuse in the workers' compensation setting. The Committee forwarded their recommendations pertaining to the AMA guides, Sixth Edition to the Workers' Compensation Commission for consideration.

#### IV. PUBLIC MEETINGS

The Physician Advisory Committee held two regular public meetings in 2020. Copies of the agendas and minutes for each of the meetings are included in the Appendix to this report.

Regular meetings of the Physician Advisory Committee for calendar year 2021 are scheduled for March 26, 2021, June 11, 2021, September 10, 2021, and November 5, 2021. The meetings are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. in the second floor Commission Chambers at the Workers' Compensation Commission, 1915 N. Stiles Avenue, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.
