UPDATE: State's Average Weekly Wage and Maximum Benefit Amounts for Work-Related Injuries, Illnesses and Deaths for CY 2023

To: Workers' Compensation Insurance Carriers, Self-Insured Employers, Group Self-Insurance Associations, Third Party Administrators, Injured Workers, Attorneys, Other Interested Parties

Date: October 26, 2022

Title 85A sets the maximum compensation benefit rates based on a percentage of the state's average weekly wage reported to the Commission by the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission.

Due to an <u>INCREASE</u> in the state average weekly wage, the maximum compensation benefit rate for injury, illness or death will change as follows:

- For temporary total disability, the <u>maximum</u> rate is \$986.86 per week for injuries and illnesses arising during the period beginning January 1, 2023 and ending December 31, 2023. 85A O.S. § 45(A).
- For Permanent Total Disability (PTD) and Death, the <u>maximum</u> rate is \$986.86 per week for work-related injury, illness or death occurring during the period beginning January 1, 2023 and ending December 31, 2023. 85A O.S. § 45(D) (regarding PTD), and 85A O.S. § 47 (regarding death benefits).
- For Permanent Partial Disability (PPD), the <u>maximum</u> compensation benefit rate remains unchanged at \$350 per week for work-related injuries and illnesses occurring on May 28, 2019 through June 30, 2021. For injuries occurring on or after July 1, 2021, the weekly rate will <u>increase</u> to \$360 per week. *See 85A O.S. § 45(C)*.
