2. <u>Request to Release Security Deposit for Resers Fine Foods Inc. fka Vaughan Foods Inc.</u> <u>Own Risk Permit #19675 and Possible Action to Approve Request</u>

Vaughan Foods, Inc. ("the Company"), own risk permit #19675, was a self-insured employer through the Own Risk program from January 1, 2005 to February 1, 2011. The company was purchased by Resers Fine Foods Inc. on September 16, 2011. The Commission held a \$100,000 surety bond issued by Travelers Casualty & Surety Co. as a security deposit. The Company petitioned the Commission to release its collateral in full.

Resers Fine Foods Inc. fka Vaughan Foods Inc. complied with Commission Rule 810:25-9-19.

Sharon Smith was recognized, introduced Carla Jacobs as the Commission's new Permitting Services employee, presented, and answered questions of the Commission.

Motion: Commissioner Biggs moved to approve request to release security deposit of Resers Fine Foods Inc. fka Vaughan Foods, Inc.

3. <u>Request to Release Security Deposit for HCA Inc., Own Risk Permit #18760 and Possible</u> <u>Action to Approve Request</u>

HCA Healthcare fka HCA Inc. ("the Company"), own risk permit #18760, left the selfinsured Own Risk program on December 31, 1997. The commission currently holds a \$100,000.00 surety bond issued by Westchester Fire Insurance Company as a security deposit. They have petitioned the Commission to release their collateral in full.

HCA Inc. has complied with Commission Rule 810:25-9-19.

5. <u>Discussion and Possible Action to Adopt OMES Progressive Discipline Standards as</u> <u>WCC 7 Progressive Discipline Policy</u>

In accordance with OAC 260:130-27-5, the OMES Human Capital Management Civil Service Division developed standards for the progressive discipline process to be used by all state agencies. This rule became effective September 11, 2022, and the Commission has followed these standards since then, when appropriate. The discussion and possible action will be to formally integrate this set of standards into the Commission's internal set of policies as policy number WCC 7.
