5. <u>Discussion and Possible Action on the Design Proposal from Cyntergy regarding Denver N. Davison Building Renovation</u>

Cyntergy submitted a design proposal for architectural and engineering design services on August 17, 2020, for the partial First and Second Floor Office Renovations in the Denver N. Davison Building. The Commission will discuss and consider action on the proposal.
