The Workers' Compensation Commission will hold a Special Meeting on **January 27, 2020** at 1:30 p.m. in the Commission Chambers on the 2nd Floor of the Denver Davison Building. The purpose of this special meeting is to consider the report of external consultant Fair Health on the Oklahoma Workers' Compensation Medical Fee Schedule. The Commission will also consider approval of the draft amended Fee Schedule proposed by Fair Health. The draft schedule will then be published for a 30-day written comment period and a verbal comment meeting.

Once approved for public review, the Fee Schedule will be posted on the Commission website at <https://www.ok.gov/wcc/>. Members of the public will be provided 30 days to provide feedback and comments on the Fee Schedule. Written comments should be submitted via email to feeschedulecomments@wcc.ok.gov.

On **February 27, 2020** the Workers' Compensation Commission will hold a Special Meeting at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission Chambers on the 2nd Floor of the Denver Davison Building to receive public oral comment. Interested parties must sign in at the door. At the close of this meeting the public written and oral comment periods will end.

Since September 2019, the Workers' Compensation Commission has worked with consulting firm, Fair Health, to review and update Oklahoma's Medical Fee Schedule. . To ensure an impartial review, Fair Health developed a data-driven approach through regional and nationwide comparisons of Oklahoma's fee schedule rates. They compared market information from a variety of sources and both public and private payers.
